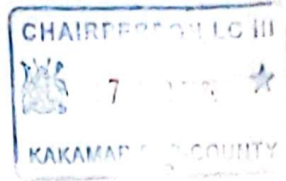

RE: URGENT REQUEST FOR THE REPAIR OF BROKEN HANDPUMPS IN THE PARISH OF KAKAMAR.

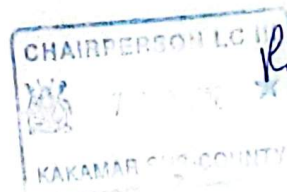
Warm greetings from the women Advocates of Kakamar Sub County at large. Kakamar Women Advocacy group is structure of Women-Led that is supported by Karamoja Women Umbrella Organization (KAWUO) to help our community in advocacy and amplifying women voices to ensure inclusivity in planning and decision making processes to enhance proper service delivery through holding duty bearers accountable both at the community, district, regional and national levels.

I am therefore writing on behalf of the residents of Kakamar, Natumgerae, Kayokong and Katiktik Villages to urgently bring to your attention the non-functional handpumps in these villages. Currently two primary boreholes located at the market centres of Natumgerae and Katiktik are broken down and they have been out of service for over two months.

The breakdown of these pumps has resulted in severe hardships for our community, particularly women and children who are now forced to walk long distances to fetch water. Many are forced to rely on unsafe water sources which is a major health hazard and increases the risk of waterborne diseases such as typhoid and it has levied more workload on women despite of the other household chores.

As a community of Kakamar, we are committed to maintaining a functional water supply and we are operating under a pay-as-you fetch model to fund small repairs. However, the current damage is beyond local repair capacity and requires the technical intervention from the sub-county or district especially if the issue is linked to iron pipe corrosion which is a known issue in our region.

1. **Send a team of handpump mechanics to assess and repair the broken handpumps immediately.**
2. **Provide a timeline for when the repairs will be completed.**
3. **Facilitate the supply of quality, non-corroded spare parts for long-term sustainability.**

Water is a fundamental human right necessary for life, sanitation and development. We trust that you will prioritize this matter to ensure our community has access to clean, safe water.

As we wait for your positive response, Kakamar women Advocates would wish to thank the Ugandan Government and Kaabong District Local Government for the decentralised services that are being provided in Kakamar Sub County as stipulated in Part 2 of the Second Schedule of the Local Governments Act and Article 176(2) of the Constitution of the Republic of Uganda and the key services detailed in this schedule include medical and health services, water and sanitation services, roads and transport, education services, social and community development among others.
